**RESOLUTION APPROVING AN ALLOCATION FROM THE AB 109 REALIGNMENT
TRUST FUND TO BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND RECOVERY SERVICES TO
PROVIDE REENTRY SERVICES TO FORMERLY INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS
THROUGH THE DAVID LEWIS COMMUNITY REENTRY CENTER IN THE CITY OF
EAST PALO ALTO IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$214,000**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 2436 (Chapter 779, Statutes of 2006) established a partnership between the East Palo Alto Police Department, the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation and community organizations to implement a three-and-a-half year pilot parolee reentry program in the City of East Palo Alto; and

WHEREAS, from 2007 through 2010, the program provided case management, advocacy and supportive services, and personal development classes yielding positive results; and

WHEREAS, state funding for the program ended in 2010 and City of East Palo Alto funding ended in April 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City of East Palo Alto and the staff of the David Lewis Community Reentry Center have been unsuccessful in finding a new permanent funding source; and

WHEREAS, your Board approved \$35,000 in bridge funding to the David Lewis Community Reentry Center in May 2014 from the County's FY 2014-15 AB 109 funding; and

WHEREAS, there continues to be a high need for reentry services in the cities of East Palo Alto, Menlo Park and surrounding areas due to a higher concentration of supervisees on Post Release Community Supervision; and

WHEREAS, the David Lewis Community Reentry Center will serve as a satellite office of the County's Service Connect program and will provide reentry rehabilitative services to the AB 109 populations of the cities and surrounding areas.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors approves the allocation of AB 109 Realignment Trust Fund monies to Behavioral Health and Recovery Services to provide reentry services to formerly incarcerated individuals through the David Lewis Community Reentry Center in the City of East Palo Alto in an amount not to exceed \$214,000.
