St. Peter's Episcopal Church in Redwood City on its 150th Anniversary.

WHEREAS, St. Peter's Episcopal Church was founded in Redwood City in September 1864; and

WHEREAS, in 1867, the Episcopal community built St. Peter's, "Little Red Church," a familiar downtown Redwood City landmark for six decades. In 1925, the parish moved to its present location on Clinton Street, adding the parish hall, sanctuary, classrooms, and offices; and

WHEREAS, for a century and a half, St. Peter's Church has responded to the changing needs of the community with two consistent "character traits:" leadership and a warm welcome for all; and

WHEREAS, for many years, St. Peter's Episcopal Church has provided community services to residents of Redwood City, extending charity to the less fortunate; and

WHEREAS, St. Peter's Episcopal Church has provided supplies, backpacks and uniforms to local schools, served meals and prepared countless "Hope Bags" for the homeless; and

WHEREAS, St. Peter's Episcopal Church serves young people of Redwood City with a Montessori preschool, the Ragazzi Boys Choir, and St. Peter's Youth group; and

WHEREAS, today its parishioners come from all walks of life, and its congregation reflects and welcomes Redwood City's diversity; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, honors St. Peter's Episcopal Church on the historic occasion of its 150th anniversary and its legacy of service to the community.
