Subject: Nomination to appoint Daneca Halvorson and Helen Fisicaro to the San Mateo County Treasury Oversight Committee

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the nomination by the Treasurer-Tax Collector for the appointment of Daneca Halvorson and Helen Fisicaro to the San Mateo County Treasury Oversight Committee.

BACKGROUND:

Per California Government Code 27131, the County Treasurer has elected to appoint the Treasurer of Daly City and the Mayor of Colma to serve on the Treasury Oversight Committee. A recruitment letter was mailed to several candidates. After a review of the applicants, and in accordance with the County Investment Policy, the Treasurer-Tax Collector nominates Daneca Halvorson and Helen Fisicaro subject to the Board of Supervisor's confirmation.

Ms. Halvorson is the Treasurer of Daly City and served as Deputy City Treasurer for over twelve years. She took the place of Tony Zidich, the former Treasurer of Daly City who retired this year and served on the Treasury Oversight Committee for several years.

Ms. Fisicaro is the Mayor of Colma and has served on the Colma Town Council since 1994 overseeing the town's budget and Treasury functions. She retired from Pacific Gas and Electric in 2010 after almost forty years of service and is currently self-employed as a management consultant.

Inclusion of these two candidates on the Treasury Oversight Committee creates representation from both the largest and smallest city/town in the County.
