WHEREAS, Ollie Mayer was one of the primary voices for decades opposing the construction of the Devil's Slide Bypass highway project; and

WHEREAS, Ollie Mayer helped spearhead the public support for a tunnel solution to the Devil's Slide dilemma, becoming a widely recognized leader in the movement that resulted in the overwhelming decision by San Mateo County voters to reject a Montara Mountain bypass in favor of a tunnel; and

WHEREAS, Ollie Mayer died shortly before the opening of the Tom Lantos Tunnels at Devil's Slide, her legacy of environmental activism on the San Mateo County Coast should be remembered for its defining force in the region.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby designates the Ollie Mayer Vista Point at Devil's Slide Trail Park in the San Mateo County Parks Department in honor of Ollie Mayer, an environmental champion who worked tirelessly to enhance the natural beauty and usefulness of San Mateo County's open spaces.
