**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING  
AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF SAN BRUNO TO  
PROVIDE CONGREGATE NUTRITION AND TRANSPORTATION SERVICES,  
EXTENDING THE TERM THROUGH JUNE 30, 2015, AND INCREASING THE  
AMOUNT BY \$105,085 TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$140,114**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, on September 15, 2014, the Director of Aging and Adult Services (AAS) authorized an agreement with the City of San Bruno to provide congregate nutrition and transportation services for individuals 60 years and older for the term July 1, 2014, through September 30, 2014, in an amount not to exceed \$35,029; and

**WHEREAS**, this agreement was only for a three-month term due to the change in funding structures and reporting requirements as a result of the Federal Sequester of Older Americans Act (OAA) funding; and

**WHEREAS**, both parties now wish to amend the agreement to extend the term through June 30, 2015, and increase the funding by \$105,085 for a new maximum fiscal obligation of \$140,114; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has been presented with a form of said amendment, has examined and approved it as to both form and content, and desires to enter into it.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief of the Health System or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
