RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING

A REVENUE AGREEMENT WITH SOUTH BAY RECYCLING (SBR) TO PROVIDE A WORK PROGRAM FOR VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION SERVICES PARTICIPANTS WITH EMPLOYMENT BARRIERS THROUGH SBR'S RECYCLING PROGRAM IN WHICH SBR WILL REIMBURSE THE COUNTY FOR PARTICIPANT WAGES, INCENTIVE BONUSES, SUPERVISION COSTS AND ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS, IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT SBR WILL REIMBURSE UP TO \$7,650,661 OVER THE THREE YEAR TERM OF JANUARY 1, 2015 TO DECEMBER 31, 2017

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, San Mateo County residents with barrier to employment are in need of training in order to obtain successful employment, and the Vocational Rehabilitation Services (VRS) of the Human Services Agency is teaming up with the recycling industry to provide paid job training and employment opportunities to the hard to employ population; and

WHEREAS, with your Board's support of this revenue Agreement, VRS participants with employment barriers will be placed into a paid job training program, which will open up job opportunities, and lead to self-sufficiency and SBR agrees to reimburse VRS for wages paid to the participants, incentive bonuses, the cost of supervision and administrative costs anticipated up to \$7,650,661 over the three year term of January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, This work program is designed to serve 50 or more participants

annually, the actual number could be higher or lower and the amount reimbursed to VRS will vary based on the number of participants hired by SBR into the work program, but reimbursements shall be based on actual costs associated with wages, incentive bonuses, the cost of supervision and administration costs to operate the program; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such Agreement and has examined and approved it as to both form and contents and desires to enter into the same; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

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
