RECOMMENDATION:

BACKGROUND:

The Employee of the Month program was established in December 1984 to recognize and honor County employees who consistently demonstrate an outstanding level of performance.

Our Employee of the Month for November 2014 is Norma Pantoja, a Payroll/Personnel Services Supervisor, in the Human Services Agency.

DISCUSSION:

Norma began her career with the County's Human Services Agency (HSA) in 2002. She has held several positions during her 12 years with HSA including Community Worker, Office Assistant, Fiscal Office Assistant, Office Specialist, and now she serves as a Payroll/Personnel Services Supervisor.

Norma is an invaluable part of the HSA team as she has vast knowledge of the payroll/personnel function. She demonstrates a "can-do" approach and a friendly, patient, and thoughtful way of assisting staff. Norma is also generous with her time as she often volunteers to assist when there is a need. As an example, last year the Children's Fund received over 3,000 gifts that needed to be wrapped within a short timeframe.
