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**RESOLUTION A) RATIFYING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S GRANT APPLICATION AND EXECUTED AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE VICTIM/WITNESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM GRANT FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2014 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2015; AND B) AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO SUBMIT ANNUAL GRANT APPLICATIONS AND EXECUTE SIMILAR AGREEMENTS WITH THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE VICTIM/WITNESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR FY 2015-2016 AND FY 2016-2017.**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, the San Mateo County District Attorney has applied for and has been awarded \$391,136 in grant funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Victim/Witness Assistance Program for FY 2014-15; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Mateo County District Attorney desires to undertake the Victim/Witness Assistance Program to be funded by grant monies applied for and received from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services through FY 2016-17; and

**WHEREAS**, each year, in order to apply for and receive such grant monies for such project, the County Board of Supervisors must approve the District Attorney's application for said grant and the execution of the related grant award agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, in the interest of efficiency, the San Mateo County District Attorney

is requesting that this Board authorize the District Attorney's Office to apply for and accept the above-reference grant monies through and including the FY 2016-17.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors hereby ratifies the District Attorney's application for a grant and execution of the grant award agreement with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Victim/Witness Assistance Program for FY 2014-15; and authorizes the District Attorney to submit annual grant proposals and to execute any agreements make any extensions and amendments thereof, to the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Victim/Witness Assistance Program for providing comprehensive assistance to victims of crime through FY 2016-17 provided there will continue to be no cost to the County.

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
