RESOLUTION: Ratifying the District Attorney's grant application and executed agreement with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Unserved/Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program Grant for the period of October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015; and Authorizing the District Attorney to submit annual grant applications and execute similar agreements with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Unserved/Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program for the periods of October 1, 2015 to September 30, 2016 and October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2017.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County District Attorney has applied for and has been awarded \$125,000 in grant funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Unserved/Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program for the period of October 1, 2014 to September 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County District Attorney desires to undertake the Unserved/Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program to be funded by grant monies applied for and received from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services through the September 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, each year, in order to apply for and receive such grant monies for such project, the County Board of Supervisors must approve the District Attorney's application for said grant and the execution of the related grant award agreement; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of efficiency, the San Mateo County District Attorney is requesting that this Board authorize the District Attorney's Office to apply for and accept the above-reference grant monies through and including the period of October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2017.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors hereby ratifies the District Attorney's application for a grant and execution of the grant award agreement with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Unserved/Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program for the period of October 1, 2014 to September 30, 2015; and authorizes the District Attorney to submit annual grant proposals and to execute any agreements make any extensions and amendments thereof, to the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Unserved/Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program for providing comprehensive assistance to victims of crime through the period of October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2017 provided there will continue to be no cost to the County.
