RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2014 the Board of State and Community

Corrections (BSCC) released a Request for Proposals encouraging California counties
to apply for funding under the auspices of the Edward Byrne Memorial Grant Program

(JAG); and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo desires to participate in the Enhanced Reducing Racial and Ethnic Disparity Grant Project (aka JAG) supported by Federal Formula Grant Funds and administered by The Board of State and Community Corrections; and

WHEREAS, The County of San Mateo is seeking to reduce juvenile truancy and delinquency, gang participation and violence among juveniles, substance abuse, and school violence.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors authorizes and directs the County Manager or his/her designee to submit the grant proposal for this funding and sign the Grant Agreement with the BSCC, including any amendments thereof; and that the federal grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and the County agrees to abide by the statutes and regulations governing the Federal Grants Program as well as the terms and conditions of the Grant Application as set forth by the BSCC.
