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RESOLUTION: A) ACCEPTING “TRAFFIC IMPACT STUDIES REQUIREMENTS” AS A POLICY DOCUMENT TO SUPPORT THE GENERAL PLAN SECTION 12 TRANSPORTATION GOALS AND OBJECTIVES; AND B) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO PERIODICALLY MAKE NON-SUBSTANTIVE CHANGES TO THE DOCUMENT TO REFLECT MINOR POLICY ADJUSTMENTS

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works is the County Engineer with the duty to maintain the County road system; and

WHEREAS, the County’s General Plan has an adopted Transportation section which outline the goals and objectives of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works recommends the adoption of a set of requirements which outlines the procedures to determine if proposed projects have any impact to County streets, intersections, and highways; and

WHEREAS, these requirements are presented in a document titled “Traffic Impact Study Requirements” attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, these requirements are consistent with the goals and objectives of the County General Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors accepts the recommendation of the Director of Public Works to accept "Traffic Impact Study Requirements".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Director of Public Works is authorized to incorporate non-substantive changes to the document to reflect minor policy adjustments.

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
