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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 04709

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California,

ORDAINS as follows

SECTION 1. Part 4 of the Ordinance is amended as indicated:

ALL HEALTH SYSTEM

1. The salary for Item B157, Staff Physician - Unclassified, is changed to range 9156.
2. The salary for Item F123, Staff Physician - Pediatrics, is changed to range 9156.
3. The salary for Item F124, Staff Physician, is changed to range 9156.
4. The salary for Item B170, Supervising Physician - Unclassified, is changed to range 9874.
5. The salary for Item F129, Supervising Physician - Pediatrics, is changed to range 9874.
6. The salary for Item F127, Supervising Physician, is changed to range 9874.

SECTION 2. Part 14 of the Ordinance is amended as indicated:

ORGANIZATION 20000 RETIREMENT

1. Item E053S, Retirement Investment/Financial Analyst Series is increased by 2 positions for a new total of 3 positions.

ORGANIZATION 26000 CHILD SUPPORT SERVICES

1. Item B240, Director of Child Support Services is increased by 1 position for a new total of 1 position.

ORGANIZATION 45100 PUBLIC WORKS ADMINISTRATION

1. Item E350, Fiscal Office Specialist is decreased by 1 position for a new total of 5

positions.

2. Item E403, Payroll/Personnel Services Specialist is increased by 1 position for a new total of 1 position.

ORGANIZATION 66000 SAN MATEO MEDICAL CENTER

1. Item E462, Payroll/Personnel Services Supervisor - Confidential is decreased by 1 position for a new total of 1 position.
2. Item S038S, Food Service Worker Series is decreased by 1 position for a new total of 17 positions.
3. Item D033, Health Services Manager II is increased by 1 position for a new total of 1 position.
4. Item E346S, Fiscal Office Assistant Series is decreased by 1 position for a new total of 3 positions.
5. Item E405S, Buyer Series is increased by 1 position for a new total of 2 positions.

SECTION 3. The changes in Section 1 are effective retroactive to December 21, 2014. All other changes are effective at the start of the first pay period following adoption.

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
