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**ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 04709 AND PROVIDING FOR THE
NUMBER OF ALL APPOINTED COUNTY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES AND THEIR
COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS BY RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF
SUPERVISORS**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California,
ordains as follows:

WHEREAS, section 206a(4) of the San Mateo County Charter directs the Board
of Supervisors to provide for the number of all appointed officers and employees; and

WHEREAS, sections 206a(5) and 508 of the San Mateo County Charter
authorize the Board of Supervisors to establish by ordinance or resolution the
compensation and benefits of County officers and employees;

WHEREAS, in the past, the Board has established the number of County officers
and employees and their respective compensation, other than base pay, and benefits
by annual enactment and/or amendment of a Salary Ordinance, establishment of the
same via resolution is more efficient;

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED henceforth the number of
County appointed officers and employees and their compensation and benefits shall be
established by resolution of the Board of Supervisors. Any and all prior existing Salary
Ordinances, including but not limited to Ordinance No. 04709 and any amendments

thereto, shall be repealed upon the passing of the first Salary Resolution.

SECTION 15 – EFFECTIVE DATE

Pursuant to Government Code § 25123, this ordinance shall take effect 30 days from the date of final passage.
