75th Anniversary

WHEREAS, seventy five years ago, in August 1939, visionary farmers in coastal San Mateo County formed the very first Soil Conservation District, now known as Resource Conservation Districts, in the State of California and one of the first in the nation; and

WHEREAS, the **SAN MATEO COUNTY RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT** provides non-regulatory, confidential, free assistance to landowners wishing to best manage their natural resources and accomplishes practical hands-on conservation projects; and

WHEREAS, the **SAN MATEO COUNTY RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT** manages a wide array of projects, including soil and water conservation, wildlife habitat enhancement and restoration, exotic plant species control, watershed restoration, conservation planning, rural road improvements, and many more; and

WHEREAS, the **SAN MATEO COUNTY RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT** is recognized for its good work locally, the organization is also recognized at one of the most respected RCDs in the state by the California Association of Resource Conservation Districts, demonstrated by the **SAN MATEO COUNTY RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT'S** receiving three statewide awards - District of the Year (2112), Employee of the Year (2010), and Director of the Year (2008).

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County honors, celebrates, and commends the **SAN MATEO COUNTY RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT** on its seventy fifth anniversary and looks forward to its continued contributions.
