IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY MANAGER/CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, plans and specifications have been reviewed and approved by the Director of Public Works for the San Mateo Medical Center 2nd Floor Post-Op Recovery Expansion, and said plans and specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing rates of wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that

 The plans and specifications for the aforesaid project, which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, are hereby approved and adopted as the plans and specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for said improvements.

- 2. Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing rate of wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract.
- 3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed bids to be received at the office of the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors until the hour of 11:00 a.m. Thursday, May 28, 2015 when they shall be publicly opened and declared.
- 4. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed bids to be published two (2) times in a weekly local newspaper of general circulation, published in the County, and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.

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
