Subject: Appointment to the Fatherhood Collaborative Advisory Board

RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation for the appointment of Lee Miller to the Fatherhood Collaborative Advisory Board representing member-at-large for a term expiring March 31, 2017.

BACKGROUND:

The Fatherhood Collaborative advises the Human Services Agency and the Board of Supervisors on matters addressing the importance of men and fathers taking an active role in the well-being of children and families, and organizes countywide events promoting and supporting the importance of fatherhood. Membership is comprised of San Mateo County Department representatives, Community Based Organization representatives and Community Members.

Lee Miller is a professor of political science at the College of San Mateo and is also a father who resides in San Mateo County. He is interested in serving his community and the mission of the Fatherhood Collaborative.

DISCUSSION:

Lee Miller will be a member-at-large on the Fatherhood Collaborative Advisory Board.
