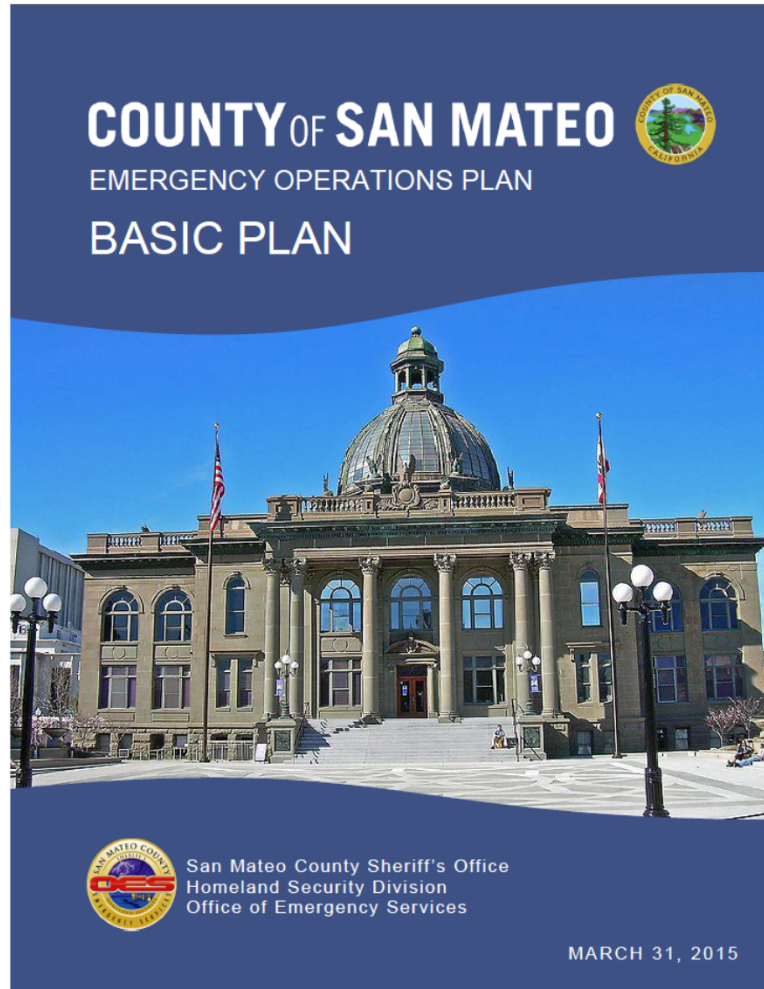

Ensures the effective coordination of response forces and resources

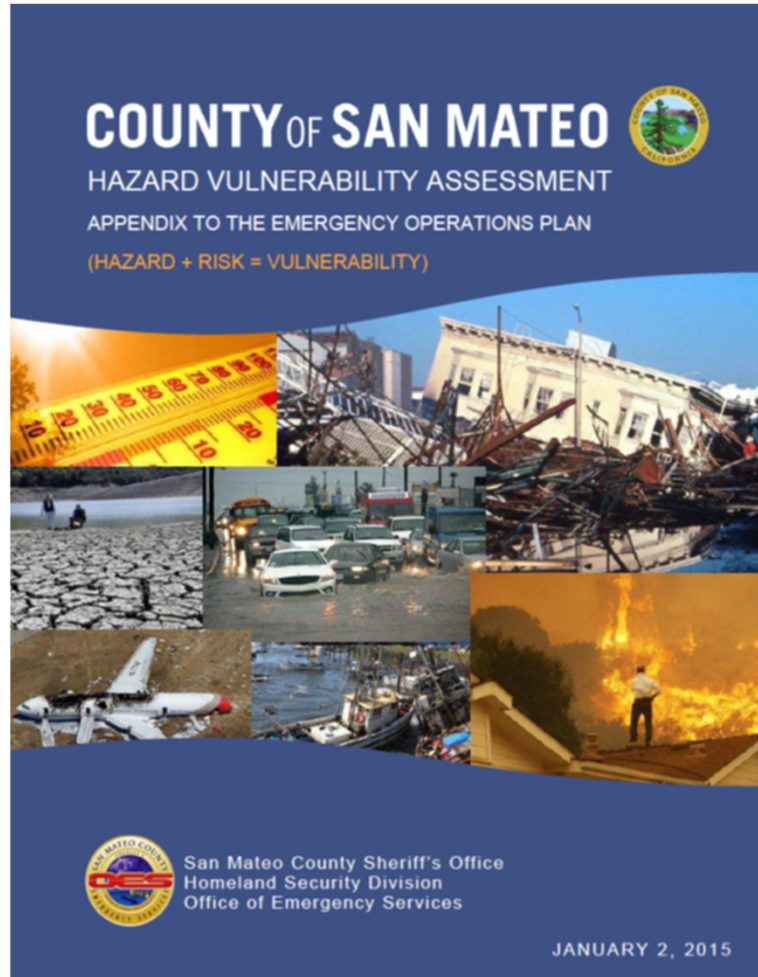
## Emergency Functions (EF):

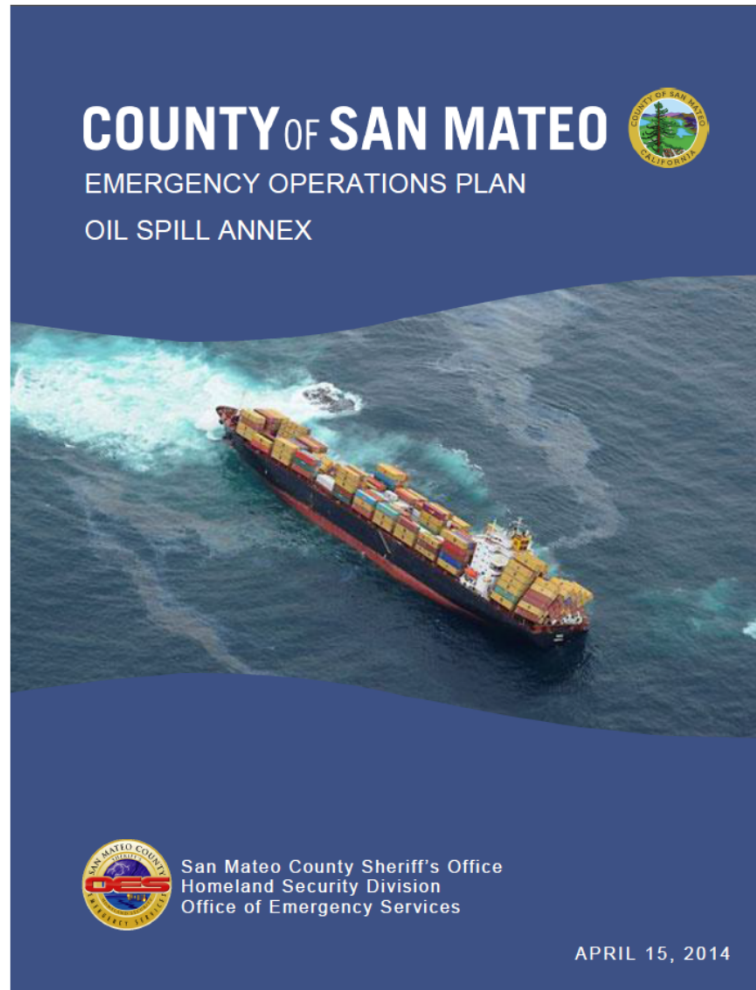


## Hazard Vulnerability Assessment:

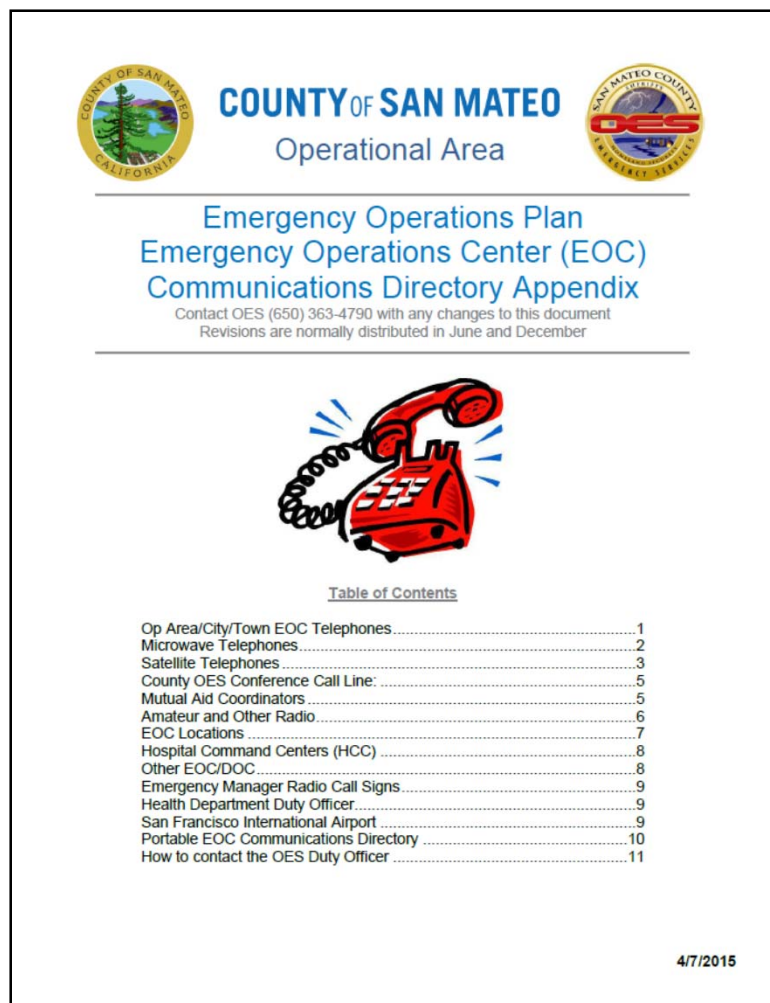
