**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO  
THE SAN MATEO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY'S MEASURE A  
PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE PROGRAM FOR THE AMOUNT OF \$300,000 TO  
UNDERTAKE DESIGN, PLANNING AND PERMITTING FOR THE COMPLETE THE  
GAP TRAIL PROJECT**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, San Mateo County Parks designs, plans, permits, constructs, operates and manages trails within the Crystal Springs Regional Trail within the San Francisco Watershed; and

**WHEREAS**, San Mateo County Parks has completed the Crystal Springs Regional Trail South of Dam segment and San Mateo County Public Works will complete the Crystal Springs Dam Bridge road and trail segment; and

**WHEREAS**, it will cost \$600,000 to design, plan and permit the 600-foot-long gap between the two trail segments just referenced; and

**WHEREAS**, the County wishes to sponsor the completion of the Complete the Gap Trail and provide \$300,000 of match funding; and

**WHEREAS**, the County seeks \$300,000 for the Complete the Gap Trail project from the San Mateo County Transportation Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 7, 1988, the voters of San Mateo County approved a ballot measure to allow the collection and distribution by the San Mateo County Transportation Authority (TA) of a half-cent transactions and use tax in San Mateo County for 25 years, with the tax revenues to be used for highway and transit improvements pursuant to the Transportation Expenditure Plan presented to the voters (Original Measure A); and

**WHEREAS**, on November 2, 2004, the voters of San Mateo County approved the continuation of the collection and distribution by the TA of the half-cent transactions and use tax for an additional 25 years to implement the 2004 Transportation Expenditure Plan beginning January 1, 2009 (New Measure A); and

**WHEREAS**, TA issued a Call for Projects for the Measure A Pedestrian and Bicycle Program on November 10, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, TA requires a governing board resolution from the County in support of the County's application for \$300,000 in San Mateo County Measure A Pedestrian and Bicycle Program funds for the Complete the Gap Trail Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorizes the submittal of a grant application to the San Mateo County Transportation Authority's Measure A Pedestrian and Bicycle Program for the amount of \$300,000 to undertake design, planning and permitting for the Complete the Gap Trail Project; and

2. Authorizes the County Parks Director to execute a funding agreement with the San Mateo County Transportation Authority to encumber any TA Measure A Pedestrian and Bicycle Program funds awarded and any subsequent documents relating to the grant; and
3. Makes it known that the County commits \$600,000 for the completion of the Complete the Gap Trail Project, including the commitment of \$300,000 of matching funds needed for implementation if awarded the requested TA Measure A Pedestrian and Bicycle Program funds.

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
