Subject: Amendment One to the FY 2010 UASI Grant Funding Agreement with the City and County of San Francisco

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the:

- A)** President of the Board of Supervisors to execute Amendment One to the Agreement with the City and County of San Francisco for distribution of FY 2010 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Funds, increasing the amount by \$668,058 to \$3,010,277;
- B)** Sheriff or Sheriff's designee(s) to sign Appendix B, grant assurances; and
- C)** Sheriff, in his capacity as OES Area Coordinator to execute amendments and minor modifications to this agreement not to exceed \$25,000; and/or to modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

BACKGROUND:

The Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) is a Federal Department of Homeland Security Grant that provides funding resources for unique equipment, training, planning, and exercise needs to 35 selected national high threat urban areas. The Bay Area UASI is one of the 35 national urban areas and one of the six identified in California.

The Bay Area UASI serves a population of 7 million and is comprised of three core cities; San Francisco, Oakland, and San Jose; 12 Bay Area counties; and over 100 incorporated cities. The geographical area covered by this region equates to approximately 8,800 square miles.

The City and County of San Francisco serves as the lead agency and contracts with the recipient agencies for distribution of UASI funds. The County has entered into agreements with the City and County of San Francisco for the past seven years in order to receive UASI funding.

On June 21, 2011, the County entered into an Agreement (Resolution No. 071487) with the City and County of San Francisco for the distribution of funds to San Mateo County as part of the FY 2010 Urban Area Security Initiative Federal Grant, in an amount not to exceed \$2,342,219 and a term commencing April 1, 2011, through January 31, 2013.

DISCUSSION:

Additional funds are being distributed by the Bay Area UASI to purchase Mobile Field Force equipment, Automated License Plate Readers, Countywide Mobile Field Force training, preparedness kits for Countywide CERT teams, and preparedness funds for reference materials and resources.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the Resolution and Amendment as to form.

Approval of this Amendment contributes to the Shared Vision 2025 outcome of a Collaborative Community through the cooperation of agencies within the County giving both regional and local responders the ability to share information and resources in real time and across borders to ensure that the public's safety, as well as that of first responders, is met in a responsible and timely manner.
