**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A) THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD TO ACCEPT A REVENUE AGREEMENT FROM SAN MATEO COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT (SMCCCD) – SKYLINE COLLEGE, TO PROVIDE TRAINING FOR A NEW WORKFORCE IN ALLIED HEALTH FOR THE TERM OF APRIL 1, 2011 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2012, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$120,000; AND B) THE DIRECTOR OF THE HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY (HSA) OR THE DIRECTOR’S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE CONTRACT AMENDMENTS IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$360,000**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, The San Mateo County Community College District (SMCCCD) through Skyline College implemented the Career Advancement Academy (CAA), a program targeting youth for bridge coursework and career technical education funded through a grant from the California Community College Chancellor’s Office; and

**WHEREAS**, Through this grant SMCCCD has awarded the County a revenue Agreement in the amount of \$120,000 with the term of April 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012, the grant is renewable for three years; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been requested that this Board authorize the Director of the Human Services Agency or the Director’s designee to accept and execute subsequent amendments on behalf of the County of San Mateo, in an amount up to \$360,000; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has been presented with a form of such revenue Agreement and said Board has examined and approved same as to both form and content and desires to enter into same.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that

A. The President of this Board of Supervisors be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to execute said revenue Agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto; and

B. The Director of the Human Services Agency, or the Director's designee is hereby authorized to execute contract amendments in an amount up to \$360,000, on behalf of the County of San Mateo.

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
