RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PROJECT LABOR AGREEMENT WITH THE SAN MATEO COUNTY BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION TRADES COUNCIL AND SIGNATORY UNIONS FOR THE REPLACEMENT JAIL PROJECT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in December 2010, the Board of Supervisors acquired 4.85 acres of land in Redwood City east of Highway 101 for the purpose of constructing a replacement jail and the Board approved a mitigated negative declaration for the construction of a replacement jail on that location; and

WHEREAS, a Site Management Plan (SMP) and the mitigated negative declaration has been approved by the Board of Supervisors for the Replacement Jail location; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County and general public to have the Replacement Jail project proceed in an orderly and cost efficient manner without labor disruption or strife; and

WHEREAS, having a Project Labor Agreement in place will allow the project to proceed without labor disruption; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with the Project Labor Agreement

and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the same.; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

County Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute a Project Labor Agreement with the San Mateo County Building and Construction Trades Council, and all trades unions that will perform work on the San Mateo County Replacement Jail Project.
