**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DISCHARGE FROM ACCOUNTABILITY FOR
COLLECTION OF CIVIL PENALTIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$62,803.27, RELATING
TO CONSUMER FRAUD JUDGMENTS**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, under Government Code Section 25257 and 25258, the Board of Supervisors can discharge the County from Continued efforts to collect funds owed to the County; and

WHEREAS, the accounts presented for discharge of accountability for the collection thereof are too small to justify the cost of collection or due to the status of the entity in question the likelihood of collection does not warrant the expense involved; and

WHEREAS, the amount of abandonment of collection effort and relief of accountability for civil penalties ordered pursuant to judgments from law enforcement cases is in the amount of \$62,803.27; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to terminate any further efforts in the collection of these accounts.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the accounts presented are not collectable and the County is hereby discharged from

continued efforts to collect funds owed to the County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Attorney's Office is discharged from accountability of the accounts presented.
