**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH BAYSPORT, INC. TO
PROVIDE WELLNESS CLINIC SCREENING SERVICES TO COUNTY EMPLOYEES
FOR THE TERM OF JANUARY 1, 2013 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2013 IN AN
AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$125,000**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County is committed to ensuring the health and wellbeing of its employees; and

WHEREAS, the County has established strategic partnerships with Blue Shield of California and Kaiser Permanente to improve employee health by providing wellness screenings, online and onsite wellness programs and activities, with a goal of reaching at least 50% of employees in 2013;

WHEREAS, Baysport was selected by an RFP process to provide Wellness Screenings to at least 50% of employees in 2013;

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board for its consideration and acceptance an Agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, whereby Baysport shall provide wellness screenings for County employees for the period January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013, for a total compensation not to exceed \$125,000 during the contract term; and

WHEREAS, this Board has considered the Agreement and approved it as to

both form and content and desires to enter into it.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board is hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Human Resources Director or the Director's designee to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
