WHEREAS, on this 29th day of January, two thousand and thirteen, DETECTIVE ANDREW ARMANDO is honored for his dedication and exemplary service to victims of domestic violence through his work on the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office Firearms Compliance Unit; and

WHEREAS, DETECTIVE ANDREW ARMANDO has worked on the Firearms Compliance Unit to review over 1,300 restraining orders issued in San Mateo County and seized or facilitated the surrender of 349 firearms in the last two years; and

WHEREAS, DETECTIVE ANDREW ARMANDO and the Firearms Compliance Unit launched a full investigation when other agencies would not. During this investigation, they took the appropriate action to increase the victim's safety, seized numerous illegal firearms including assault rifles, and assisted in the prosecution of a batterer that would not have otherwise been pursued; and

WHEREAS, DETECTIVE ANDREW ARMANDO has gone above and beyond in his role on the Firearms Compliance Unit and has played a vital role in ensuring the safety and wellbeing of individuals throughout San Mateo County while showing compassion for victims.
