**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE FY 2012 GRANTS TO ENCOURAGE ARREST
POLICIES AND ENFORCEMENT OF PROTECTIONS ORDERS PROGRAM FOR
THE TERM OF OCTOBER 1, 2012 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2014, IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$650,000**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in 2010, the Sheriff's Office received a grant award in the amount of \$675,000 from the Community-Defined Solutions to Violence Against Women Program (now referred to as the Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders); and

WHEREAS, the Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders Program, through the US Department of Justice, enhances victim safety and offender accountability in cases of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault and stalking by encouraging jurisdictions to implement pre-arrest policies as an effective intervention that is part of a coordinated community response; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office applied for and has been awarded continuation funding from the FY 2012 Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders Program; and

WHEREAS, the funding will sustain the Domestic Violence Firearms

Compliance and Legal Advocacy Program; and

WHEREAS, funding will support one Sheriff's Detective, one Victim Liaison, a Domestic Violence Attorney and Pro Bono Attorney Coordinator, and provide training to law enforcement agencies on the laws and procedures for the service of court orders upon restrained persons; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the County of San Mateo, hereby accepts the FY 2012 Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders Program award.
