BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH ADDICTION RESEARCH AND TREATMENT, INC. FOR NARCOTIC REPLACEMENT THERAPY SERVICES, EXTENDING THE TERM THROUGH JUNE 30, 2015, AND INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$622,654 TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,245,308

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Ordinance Code Section 2.83.170 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to waive the Request for Proposals process in any situation where the Board of Supervisors determines that the best interest of the County could be served without the necessity of proposals; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been asked to waive the Request for Proposals process with Addiction Research and Treatment, Inc. for the provision of narcotic replacement therapy services; and

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the County to waive the Request for Proposals process; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2013, your Board approved an agreement with Addiction Research Treatment, Inc., for the provision of narcotic replacement therapy services, for a maximum obligation of \$622,654 for the term of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance a first amendment to the agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, increasing the maximum obligation by \$622,654 to a new maximum obligation of \$1,245,308, and extending the agreement term through June 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of the first amendment and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into this amended agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to execute said first amendment to the agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

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
