DISCUSSION:

Yahaira has been with the County since 2010. Yahaira is a valued member to the Pathways Team. She is a great team player, she communicates well and she is a wonderful person to work with. As a family partner for the mental health court these qualities have made her very valuable and successful in her work. She engages well with clients and their families, she helps them to navigate through the criminal justice system.

Yahaira provides family resources and offers a level of compassion that this population rarely sees. She adds an important perspective to the team and program as a family partner. This perspective and experience has been very beneficial to the clients in the development and execution of their treatment plans.

A family partner whose son entered the criminal justice system wrote: "Our family partner (Yahaira), became a member of our family, sharing the same goals and

personal interest in our son. She had personal experience, as well as incredible knowledge base with mental illness, which was key to understanding the pain and anguish our son was experiencing. She was also personable, compassionate, and empathetic for both client and parent/family. We needed all the help, education, and support we could get during this very difficult time and we could always count on her to be there for us".
