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RESOLUTION:

 ADOPTING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS, FOR THE FAIR OAKS SEWER MAINTENANCE DISTRICT CLOSED CIRCUIT TELEVISION PIPELINE AND MANHOLE INSPECTION PROJECT; AND
B) AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH COASTLINE WATER RESOURCES, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$374,295 FOR THE FAIR OAKS SEWER MAINTENANCE DISTRICT CLOSED CIRCUIT TELEVISION PIPELINE AND MANHOLE INSPECTION PROJECT; AND
C) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO EXECUTE SUBSEQUENT CHANGE ORDERS TO GRANT TIME EXTENSIONS FOR PROJECT COMPLETION AND PAYMENT UP TO A MAXIMUM AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$37,500 OR APPROXIMATELY 10% OF THE AGREEMENT AMOUNT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of

California, acting as the Governing Board of the Fair Oaks Sewer Maintenance District

(District), that

WHEREAS, this Board did, on January 23, 2007, adopt Resolution No. 068509,

which authorized the Director of Public Works to develop plans and specifications and

to call for bids for the types of projects identified in said resolution; and

WHEREAS, this Board did, on August 5, 2014, adopt Resolution No. 073304, re-

certifying the Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP) for the ten County Sewer

Maintenance and Sanitation Districts; and

WHEREAS, periodic visual and closed circuit television (CCTV) inspections of

manholes and sewer pipes in the District are included in Element 6 "Measures and

Activities (Operation and Maintenance Program)," of the SSMP as part of a system for ranking the condition of sewer pipes and scheduling rehabilitation work; and

WHEREAS, this Board did, on November 3, 2015, adopt Resolution No. 074167, rejecting all bids received on September 15, 2015, for the Fair Oaks Sewer Maintenance District Closed Circuit Television Pipeline and Manhole Inspection Project (Project) and directing the Director of Public Works to re-advertise the Project for bids; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications, dated August 19, 2015, have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the Fair Oaks Sewer Maintenance District Closed Circuit Television Pipeline and Manhole Inspection Project; and said plans and specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works (the "Plans and Specifications"); and

WHEREAS, the Plans and Specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Clerk of this Board of Supervisors did, in public on January 14, 2016, at 2:30 p.m., open and examine all sealed bids that were received in the specified time for the doing of the work referred to in said Plans and Specifications; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors has caused an analysis of said bids to be

made by the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo, and has, in open session, fully reviewed and considered said sealed proposals and the analysis thereof; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bid was submitted by Coastline Water Resources, Inc., in the amount of \$374,295 based on an estimate of the amount of work to be done.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The plans and specifications dated August 19, 2015, for the aforesaid project, which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and adopted as the Plans and Specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for said inspections described therein.
- 2. Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract and include specific Labor Compliance Program requirements.
- It is in the best interest of the District to award the agreement for the Fair Oaks Sewer Maintenance District Closed Circuit Television Pipeline and Manhole Inspection Project to:

- 4. The District shall enter into a written agreement with Coastline Water Resources, Inc., for the completion of said work as required by the Plans and Specifications adopted by this Board of Supervisors, as hereinbefore mentioned, which Plans and Specifications are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo.
- 5. The President of this Board of Supervisors shall be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Coastline Water Resources, Inc., for the doing of said work described therein, subject to the Department of Public Works' receipt and approval of the Faithful Performance Surety Bond ("Performance Bond") and the Labor and Material Surety Bond ("Payment Bond") required to be posted by said Contractor with the County of San Mateo in connection therewith, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.
- The Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to execute change orders related to said work for time extensions and payment not exceeding \$374,295 in aggregate.
- 7. All payments to the Contractor shall be in accordance with the Plans and Specifications, and other agreement documents. Aggregate payment to the Contractor shall not exceed \$411,795 without this Board's approval.
- The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, County of San Mateo, is hereby authorized and directed to attest the signature of the President of this Board of

Supervisors to said written agreement.

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
