RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING*

Bronstein Music Upon its 70th Anniversary

WHEREAS, during World War II, Milton joined the Army Band and was assigned to General Patton's Army Unit and Milton & Celia Bronstein founded Bronstein Music on February 9, 1946, and in the 1970s Don Edwards and Richard Welker became the co-owners of Bronstein Music; and

WHEREAS, both Don Edwards and Richard Welker started working at Bronstein Music in high school, as Mr. Bronstein wanted to hire band and music students; and

WHEREAS, Richard Welker went to USF but stayed working at Bronstein Music, and Mr. Bronstein offered him a managerial position with the intent that he would own the store five years later; and

WHEREAS, Don Edwards joined the National Guard and played in the band, then went to work for Western Electric, but all the while he stayed in contact with Richard and Mr. Bronstein, and came back to Bronstein Music as an organ department manager in 1976.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby commends Bronstein Music on its 70 Year Anniversary.
