HON. JUDGE ELIZABETH LEE

Upon Receiving the Rose Bird Memorial Award

WHEREAS, Hon. Judge Elizabeth Lee was honored with the Rose Bird Memorial at the California Women Lawyers' 16th Annual Northern California Judicial Reception on April 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Hon. Judge Elizabeth Lee was appointed to the Superior Court bench in 2005, handling criminal matters in the Northern County Courthouse; and

WHEREAS, Hon. Judge Elizabeth Lee spent four and a half years in the Juvenile Court where she presided over delinquency and dependency cases, before assuming her current position as Criminal Presiding Judge in Redwood City; and

WHEREAS, Hon. Judge Elizabeth Lee has been actively involved in improving access to justice and ensuring better outcomes for women, children, and others who enter the court system; and

WHEREAS, Hon. Judge Elizabeth Lee has made significant contributions toward the prevention of human trafficking, including her role as a frequent lecturer on the topic, her co-authorship of a Program Guide for Judges on Human Trafficking for the National Association of Women Judges, and her service as Chair of the Association's Human Trafficking Committee; and

WHEREAS, Hon. Judge Elizabeth Lee has demonstrated a deep commitment to improving the lives of at-risk youth, by serving as the former Chair of San Mateo County's Blue Ribbon Commission on Foster Care Youth, sitting as a frequent volunteer judge for the Youth Court in East Palo Alto, and serving as a member of the California Child Welfare Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County, State of California, hereby honors Hon. Judge Elizabeth Lee. We commend your service to the San Mateo County Superior Court and the County of San Mateo at large.
