CAPTAIN LISA WILLIAMS

Upon her retirement from the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office

WHEREAS, CAPTAIN LISA WILLIAMS began her law enforcement career as a clerk in the Sheriff's Office 32 years ago, in 1984, and she served in a variety of assignments including Corrections, Investigations, Emergency Services, and Patrol while earning her way up through the ranks; and

WHEREAS, CAPTAIN LISA WILLIAMS has been a mentor for women in law enforcement and has a strong interest in women's issues countywide, which she demonstrated when she was the Commander of the Women's Correctional Center by implementing cost-effective, gender-specific, responsive programming for female inmates, which included education, rehabilitation, recovery services, and personal development; and

WHEREAS, CAPTAIN LISA WILLIAMS led the efforts in creating what is now known as the Sheriff's Office Correction Division's inmate TAILS (Transitioning Animals Into Loving Situations) program, and a culinary arts program within the correctional center's transitional facility; and

WHEREAS, CAPTAIN LISA WILLIAMS currently serves as the North County Field Operations Division Commander and also serves as the Chief of Police Services for the City of Millbrae; while in the past, she led the Coastside Patrol Bureau and transitioned law enforcement services for the City of Half Moon Bay serving as their Chief of Police Services; and

WHEREAS, CAPTAIN LISA WILLIAMS has experience in addressing issues impacting youth, including gangs and gang violence, engaging the community to identify priorities and common sense solutions, as well as managing public safety for large community events; and

WHEREAS, CAPTAIN LISA WILLIAMS is a graduate of the FBI National Academy, in Quantico, Virginia, and has a Bachelor's Degree in Human Services Administration from Notre Dame de Namur University, in Belmont, California,
