RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HIRING OF RETIRED LEGAL SECRETARY CHRISTINE THORESEN TO AN EXTRA HELP POSITION IN ORDER TO PROVIDE TRAINING ON THE JUVENILE OFFICE PROCESSES, AND CERTIFYING, PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE §7522.56(F) (1), THAT THE NATURE OF EMPLOYMENT AND APPOINTMENT IS NECESSARY TO FILL A CRITICALLY-NEEDED POSITION BEFORE THE POST-RETIREMENT 180 DAY SEPARATION PERIOD EXPIRES.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the District Attorney's Office processes all petitions for prosecution for juvenile cases; and

WHEREAS, retired Legal Secretary Christine Thoresen has unique skills, expertise, and knowledge in the processing of all paperwork needed for prosecuting minors that commit crimes; and

WHEREAS, the training Christine Thoresen is able to provide to the new Legal Secretaries is essential and unattainable from current County personnel; and

WHEREAS, Government Code §7522.56 requires a One-Hundred Eighty (180) day separation period, as established by the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act, unless the employer's governing body makes a finding by certifying that the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position before the One-Hundred

Eighty (180) day separation period has passed; and

WHEREAS, Christine Thoresen's services are needed prior to the expiration of the One-Hundred-Eighty (180) day separation period; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this Resolution approving the hiring of retired Legal Secretary Christine Thoresen to extra help position in order to provide training on the juvenile office processes, and certifying, pursuant to Government Code §7522.56(f)(1), that the nature of employment and appointment is necessary to fill a critically-needed position before the post-retirement 180 day separation period expires.
