Subject: Agreement with Jacqueline Baras Shreibati, MD, MS

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt a resolution authorizing an agreement with Jacqueline Baras Shreibati, MD, MS to provide non-invasive cardiology services, for the term of August 1, 2016 through July 31, 2017, in an amount not to exceed \$280,000.

# BACKGROUND:

San Mateo County is responsible for providing necessary medical care to its medically indigent population. This includes services for cardiology disorders and the management and supervision of those services. The County's need for these cardiology services is increasing due to the aging of its patient population.

### **DISCUSSION:**

Dr. Shreibati will provide up to four half-day clinics per week, with each clinic being four hours in length to provide inpatient cardiology consults, Transesophageal Echocardiogram interpretations, Electrocardiogram (EKGs) readings, Stress Echocardiograms (Stress Echo), Stress Tests, and Holter Monitors. Dr. Shreibati also will provide call coverage six days per month.

County Administrative Memorandum B-1 provides that contracts for physicians are exempt from the Request for Proposals process.

The Resolution contains the County's standard provisions allowing amendment of the County's fiscal obligation by a maximum of \$25,000 (in aggregate).

The agreement and Resolution have been reviewed and approved by County Counsel as to form.

Approval of this agreement contributes to the Shared Vision 2025 outcome of a Healthy Community by providing San Mateo County residents with access to non-invasive cardiology services. It is anticipated that 100% of all EKGs, Stress Echo and Holter Monitor test results will be read and interpreted within 24 hours of admission.

# FISCAL IMPACT:

The term of the agreement is August 1, 2016 through July 31, 2017. The amount of the agreement is not to exceed \$280,000. Funds in the amount of \$256,667 will be included in the SMMC FY 2016-17 Recommended Budget. Similar arrangements will be made for future budget years.

Expenses at SMMC are covered by fees for services or third-party payors whenever possible. The portion of expenses for services provided to the medically indigent or to those covered by programs that do not meet the full costs of care are covered by the County's General Fund contribution to SMMC, and are within the existing annual appropriation.
