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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONTROLLER TO PAY NON-CONTRACT MEDICAL SERVICE PROVIDERS AT NON-COUNTY FACILITIES TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO COUNTY INMATES NOT AVAILABLE AT A COUNTY SITE FOR THE TERM JULY 1, 2015 THROUGH JUNE 30 2018, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,500,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, it is sometimes necessary to send County inmates to medical care providers at non-County facilities that do not contract with San Mateo County when the services or procedures they require are not available at a County site; and

WHEREAS, California Assembly Bill 658, enacted July 16, 2015, authorizes hospitals that do not contract for health care services with the county sheriff, police chief, or other public agency to provide health care services to local law enforcement patients and to be reimbursed for such services at a rate equal to 110 percent of the hospital's actual costs; and

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that continued funding for such noncontract providers is warranted and that it is appropriate to vest the Chief of the Health System with the authority to secure such medical services for County inmates and that it is appropriate to authorize and direct the Controller to pay for such authorized medical services. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Controller is hereby authorized and directed to execute payments for medical services authorized by the Chief of the Health System to non-contract medical service providers who provide services at non-County facilities to County inmates for whom the County has responsibility as follows: at a rate equal to 110 percent of the hospital's actual costs according to the most recent Hospital Annual Financial Data report issued by the Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development, as calculated using a cost-to-charge ratio.

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
