Raymond Bagley upon his 100th Birthday

WHEREAS, Raymond Bagley was born June 6, 1916 in Minnesota and had various odd jobs in Southern California, where it was customary in those times to wait on the street corner for employers who would seek out men for hire, which led to a job on a dude ranch out in the valley where he taught regular folk and some move stars to ride, one of whom was Jimmy Cagney; and

WHEREAS, Ray Bagley later joined the Navy, where he learned the plumbing trade, which served him well even after retirement, and when his service with the Navy ended he moved to San Francisco and found work building the Brentwood subdivision near San Francisco where Benny Segal had bought a plot of land in South San Francisco just to employ and home military families after WWII. There he purchased a house where he raised his family and lives today, and still retains the original deed signed by Benny "Bugsy" Segal himself; and

WHEREAS, Ray Bagley did plumbing in the Westlake subdivision as the homes were being built, and his plumbing skills gave him employment at the New Mission Plumbing and Heating on Hillside and then to Atlas Heating and Ventilation, and is a member of the Plumber's Union Local 104 and 38.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby commends Raymond Bagley on his 100th Birthday.
