BACKGROUND:

The mission of the San Mateo County Commission on Aging is to improve the quality of life for seniors in San Mateo County through the promotion of independence, self-sufficiency, mental and physical health, as well as community involvement.

JoAnne Arnos is a resident of Pacifica and is a Senior Peer Counselor at Peninsula Family Service. A Radiologic Technologist by profession, JoAnne has many years working with under-represented seniors, especially the LGBTQ community. She has worked with the Commission on Aging Adult Abuse Prevention and Resource Access committees. JoAnne has partnered with the Elder and Dependent Adult Protection Team (EDAPT) Outreach Coordinator for community outreach efforts.

Mary Larenas is a resident of Moss Beach and is a PhD psychotherapist focusing on adult and geriatric mental health. She has served as a recent Chairperson of the Commission on Aging and is an advisory member of the Measure A funded Aging and Adult Services Elder and Dependent Adult Protection Team (EDAPT). Mary also serves as chairperson for the Commission on Aging Adult Abuse Prevention Committee.
