RESOLUTION: (A) ACCEPTING THE CERTIFICATE OF THE CHIEF ELECTIONS OFFICER AS THE STATEMENT OF THE RESULTS OF THE VOTE AS DETERMINED BY THE OFFICIAL CANVASS OF THE JUNE 7, 2016 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION; AND (B) DECLARING THE PERSON(S) ELECTED TO OR NOMINATED FOR CERTAIN OFFICES; AND (C) DECLARING APPOINTED IN LIEU OF HOLDING AN ELECTION THE PERSON(S) WHO FILED DECLARATIONS OF CANDIDACY; AND (D) DECLARING THE RESULTS OF LOCAL BALLOT MEASURES.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Chief Elections Officer has completed the official canvass of the completed returns of the votes cast during the Presidential Primary Election held throughout the County of San Mateo on June 7, 2016, has prepared in accordance with law a Statement of the Votes polled at said election held on said date, and has presented a certified copy of said statement to this Honorable Board; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Elections Officer will deliver a duplicate of the certified statement to the California Secretary of State and to the county central committee of each political party; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Elections Officer will submit to the governing bodies of the participating local jurisdictions the certificates of the election so that each shall declare the results for each office or measure under its jurisdiction pursuant to Sections

15400 and 8140 of the Elections Code; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Elections Officer has also determined that the number of persons who filed declarations of candidacy for certain offices does not exceed the number of positions available; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Elections Officer will deliver to each person elected or appointed in lieu of election a certificate of election, signed and authorized by the Chief Elections Officer; and

WHEREAS, this Board is the governing body for the County of San Mateo.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND HEREBY ORDERED that the Deputy Clerk of the Board shall enter upon the minutes of this meeting of this Board of Supervisors said abstract or Statement of the Votes polled at said election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said abstract or Statement of the Votes polled shall be and is hereby adopted as the official vote of said election held throughout the County of San Mateo, State of California, on June 7, 2016; and
