AMENDMENT NO. THREE TO THE AGREEMENT FOR OPERATION OF THE PESCADERO SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND ALLIED WASTE INDUSTRIES

THIS AMENDMENT NO. THREE to that certain Agreement, dated August 12, 2008 by and between the County of San Mateo, hereinafter referred to as "County", and BFI Waste Systems of North America, LLC dba Allied Waste Services of San Mateo County, referred to as "Contractor" and is entered into this _____ day of August 2016;

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties hereto entered into an Agreement dated July 31, 2008 on August 12, 2008, whereby Contractor provides services and certain equipment necessary to operate the Pescadero Solid Waste Transfer Station in San Mateo County and to transport and dispose of solid waste and recyclables from said transfer station in accordance with the terms and conditions of said Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto wish to amend said Agreement to extend its term and modify the Contractor fee schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. <u>Section C. Duration of Contract/Termination</u>, Item 1. is hereby amended to add the following: "Pursuant to these extension provisions, the term of this agreement is extended twelve (12) months to include the time period starting August 15, 2016 and ending on August 14, 2017. Upon expiration of the twelve (12) month extension, this agreement may be extended by the parties' execution of a written amendment consistent with the above extension provisions."
- 2. Exhibits "A" and "B" attached hereto replace the Contractor's fee schedules included in the Agreement and prior amendment.

Exhibit "A" is consistent with Exhibit "A" attached to Amendment No. Two effective July 1, 2015 and is restated with this Amendment.

Exhibit "B" is effective August 9, 2016 and is consistent with Exhibit "B" attached to Amendment No. Two, except for the rate per ton for "Mattress/Box Springs". Allied Waste Industries is participating in the Mattress Recycling Council (MRC) Collection Program (Program) and is receiving reimbursement for collection, transferring, and processing of mattresses/box springs from the MRC. As a participant in the MRC program, Allied Waste Industries is being reimbursed through the Program and the Contractor's fee schedule should be reflective of this. Additionally, while Allied Waste Industries participates in the

Program, they are required to waive all fees charged to the public while participating in this program. Exhibit "B" acknowledges the Program, participation in the Program, and non-participation in the Program. In connection with the collection of Mattress/Box Springs, Allied Waste Industries is required to continue to provide documentation to the County of the number of Mattress/Box Springs collected at the facility.
