WHEREAS, on Friday November 18, 2016, the SEQUOIA HIGH SCHOOL DREAM CLUB is holding its seventh Annual “Making Dreams Come True Dinner” to raise funds to give scholarships to graduating undocumented high school seniors; and

WHEREAS, the SEQUOIA HIGH SCHOOL DREAM CLUB began in 2009 to raise awareness about the challenges faced by undocumented students and the need for more private scholarship dollars to make up for the absence of public aid; and

WHEREAS, the SEQUOIA HIGH SCHOOL DREAM CLUB has raised more than \$40,000 in scholarship donations for undocumented high school students to attend college; and

WHEREAS, the SEQUOIA HIGH SCHOOL DREAM CLUB sponsors an annual conference in February to build awareness, connection and confidence, and to guide undocumented youth towards resources that will help them get into college, deal with emotional challenges of growing up undocumented, and understand immigration law; and

WHEREAS, the SEQUOIA HIGH SCHOOL DREAM CLUB is the only school student club in San Mateo County dedicated to supporting “Dreamers” by creating limitless educational opportunities to pursue their dreams.
