**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO
APPLY FOR COMPETITIVE FUNDING UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE EDWARD
BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT THROUGH THE BOARD OF
STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS FOR THE FUNDING CYCLE OF
JANUARY 1, 2017 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2017**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo desires to participate in the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program supported by federal Formula Grant funds and administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections (hereafter referred to as BSCC; and

WHEREAS, in October 2016, the BSCC released a Request for Applications (RFA) for Year Three funding for recipients of Year Two funding; and

WHEREAS, the County responded to the RFA and was awarded \$830,474 in Year Three funding to continue the implementation of its Students With Amazing Goals (SWAG) program—a truancy prevention and high school graduation supportive services program for at-risk high school youth in the City of East Palo Alto and the Belle Haven neighborhood of Menlo Park;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the County Manager or his designee is authorized on behalf of the Board of Supervisors to

submit the grant proposal for this funding and sign the Grant Agreement with the BSCC, including any amendments thereof; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that federal grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the county agrees to abide by the statutes and regulations governing the federal Formula Grants Program as well as the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC.
