2. Section 2 of the Agreement: <u>Payments</u> is hereby amended to read as follows:

In consideration of the services provided by Contractor in accordance with all terms, conditions, and specifications set forth in this Agreement and in Exhibit A, County shall make payment to Contractor based on the rates and in the manner specified in Exhibit B,

and D1. County reserves the right to withhold payment if County determines that the quantity or quality of the work performed is unacceptable. This amendment adds seventy two thousand one hundred three dollars, (\$72,103) to cover the total cost of services for the term of the Agreement. In no event shall County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED THREE DOLLARS, (\$172,103). In the event that the County makes any advance payments, Contractor agrees to refund any amounts in excess of the amount owed by the County at the time of contract termination or expiration. Contractor is not entitled to payment for work not performed as required by this agreement.

- 3. Exhibit D2 hereby replaces original Exhibits D and D1 in their entirety and is incorporated by reference herein.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of the original agreement for the term of January 1, 2017 through June 30, 2017 between the County and Contractor for kinship support services shall remain in full force and effect.
