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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACTING PARKS DIRECTOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO
ACCEPT A CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION GRANT
FOR THE MEMORIAL COUNTY PARK CRUMB CLEAN PROGRAM IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$54,000**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, San Mateo County wants to continue efforts to aid the recovery of the marbled murrelet through the Memorial County Park Crumb Clean Program with trained seasonal Park Aides to educate and assist visitors by developing messages, distributing informational materials and purchasing animal-proof trash cans in conjunction with California Department of Parks and Recreation staff; and

WHEREAS, funding for this grant comes from mitigation fund accounts associated with oil spills caused by a leaking, sunken vessel, the SS Jacob Luchenbach; and

WHEREAS, San Mateo County will enter into an agreement with the California Department of Parks and Recreation for grant funding in the amount of \$54,000 to implement the Memorial County Park Crumb Clean Program beginning summer 2017 and ending in 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Acting Parks Director, or designee, is hereby authorized to accept a California State Parks and Recreation grant for the Memorial County Park Crumb Clean Program in the amount of \$54,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Acting Parks Director, or designee, is authorized to execute any other documents associated with acceptance of this grant funding from California State Parks and Recreation.

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
