RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A ONE-TIME \$34,000 GRANT OF DISTRICT-SPECIFIC MEASURE K FUNDS TO COMMUNITY OVERCOMING RELATIONSHIP ABUSE TO PROVIDE SUPERVISION FOR COMMUNITY ADVOCATES IN SUPPORT OF TWO NEW, POPULATION-SPECIFIC PROGRAMS, AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO PREPARE AND EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Measure K is the half-cent general sales tax initially approved by

San Mateo County voters in November 2012, and extended in November 2016 for a

total of thirty years; and

WHEREAS, the Board and County staff have conducted study sessions and

community outreach efforts to inform priorities for Measure K spending; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2015 the Board of Supervisors adopted the Measure K allocation plan for the FY 2015-17 budget, which included district-specific funds in the amount of \$5 million in one-time loans or grants, and \$1 million each year for FY 2015-16 and FY 2016-17, divided equally among the supervisorial districts, for district-specific needs and projects; and

WHEREAS, on April 28, 2015 the Board of Supervisors, as recommended by the Measure K Subcommittee, approved continuing and/or expanding initiatives and projects for FY 2015-16 and FY 2016-17, as well as the criteria and process to be used to administer district-specific Measure K funds; and

WHEREAS, Supervisorial District 4 has requested a one-time \$34,000 grant for

FY 2016-17 for Community Overcoming Relationship Abuse (CORA) to provide supervision for community advocates in support of two new, population-specific programs; and

WHEREAS, it is the Board's intent for the County Manager, or his designee, to negotiate and execute a grant agreement in the maximum amount of \$34,000 with CORA for the purposes of confirming the expenditure of the grant funds for the objectives set forth in the Project Summary attached to this Board transmittal; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient Measure K funds in the Non-Departmental Services FY 2016-17 Adopted Budget for this purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the grant to Community Overcoming Relationship Abuse (CORA) in the maximum amount of \$34,000 is hereby approved, and the County Manager, or his designee, is authorized to prepare and execute a grant agreement with CORA in the maximum amount of \$34,000 for the purposes set forth above, to be completed during FY 2016-17.
