SUBJECT: Reappointment to the Coastside Design Review Committee

RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation for the reappointment of Beverly Garrity as a Community Representative member to the Coastside Design Review Committee, representing Montara, for a term ending March 31, 2020.

BACKGROUND:

The Coastside Design Review Committee exists to review all residential and residential/commercial mixed use projects in the Midcoast Local Coastal Program Update Project Area. The Committee reviews these projects for compliance with specific site planning and architectural standards developed for the area.

Beverly Garrity has served as a Montara Community Representative on the Coastside Design Review Committee since June 3, 2014. Planning Staff has enjoyed working with Beverly and really appreciate her kind and clear communication skills with the public and applicants. As Chair of the CDRC for approximately 3 years, the CDRC has benefited significantly from her organization skills and enthusiasm in formalizing the bylaws, procedure, and training process of the CDRC.
