RESOLUTION 2016/17-02

REQUIRING EVEN-NUMBERED YEAR ELECTIONS FOR THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Colma Fire Protection District's (District) enabling Legislation, specifically California Health & Safety 20000 *et seq.*, specifies that Fire Protection Districts are subject to the Uniformed District Election Law; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform District Election Law, specifically California Elections Code 10505, provides that elections for the Board of Fire Commissioners of the District are held on odd-numbered years, and the District currently holds its elections for members of its Fire Commission on odd-numbered years; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code sections 10505 and 10404(b), the District's Board of Fire Commissioners may, by resolution, order the elections of its Commissioners be held on the same day as the statewide general election; and

WHEREAS, California Elections Code 1001 provides that elections held in June and November of even-numbered years are statewide elections and the dates of those elections are statewide elections dates; and

WHEREAS, the terms of one member of the Fire Commission is set to expire in November of 2017 and the term of two members of the Fire Commission are set to expire in November of 2019; and

WHEREAS, the next statewide general election in November of an even-numbered year at which the members of the Board of Fire Commissioners could be elected following the expiration of the terms of the current Commissioners is November 6, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners desires, as permitted by law, to Consolidate the election of members of its Board of Fire Commissioners with the Statewide general election held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each even-numbered year.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to its rights, powers, and Authority the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Colma Fire Protection District hereby:


1. Orders the elections of its members of the District's Board of Fire Commissioners to occur regularly on the same date as the statewide general elections occurring on the first Tuesday following the first Monday in November of even-numbered years and to be consolidated with those even-numbered year elections.

Organized June 8, 1925


2. Orders such elections commence with the statewide general election to be held on November 6, 2018.
3. Acknowledges that the member of the Board of Fire Commission whose term of office will expire prior to the statewide general election in November 2018 will continue in office until their successor is elected and qualified in accordance with section 10404(i) of the California Elections Code at the November 2018 election, and that the members of the Board of Fire Commission whose terms will in December of 2019 will continue in office until their successors are elected and qualified in accordance with section 10404(i) of the California Elections Code at the November 2020 election.
4. Directs the Commission's Secretary to submit this resolution to the County of San Mateo Board of Supervisors no later than 240 days prior to the next District Election.
5. Requests the County of San Mateo Board of Supervisors administer this Resolution as set forth in Section 10404 of the California Elections Code and, within 60 days of the submission of this Resolution, approve this Resolution unless it finds that the ballot style, voting equipment, or computer capacity cannot handle the additional elections or materials, in accordance with section 10404 of the California Elections Code.


