**RATIFYING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S
SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE VICTIM/WITNESS
ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR FY2012-13, FOR FUNDS ADMINISTERED
THROUGH THE CALIFORNIA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$358,613; AND EXECUTION OF THE GRANT AWARD AGREEMENT
AND AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO MAKE ANY EXTENSIONS OR
AMENDMENTS THEREOF WHICH DO NOT REQUIRE COMMITMENT OF COUNTY
FUNDS**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, since 1974, the County of San Mateo has applied for and received funding and desires to maintain a project designated the San Mateo County Victim/Witness Assistance Program with program funding derived from State Penalty Assessments and the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) administered by the California Emergency Management Agency, (herein referred to as Cal EMA), in the amount of \$358,613; and

WHEREAS, it is agreed that the State of California and Cal EMA disclaim any responsibility for any liability, arising out of the performance of this Grant Award Agreement, and that such liability including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency; and

WHEREAS, it is agreed that any grant funds received hereunder shall not be

used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the submission of the grant application to Cal EMA and the execution of the Grant Award Agreement by the District Attorney of the County of San Mateo, on behalf of the County of San Mateo, is ratified and the District Attorney is authorized to make any extensions or amendments thereof which do not require commitment of County funds.
