**RESOLUTION APPROVING A MINOR MODIFICATION TO THE LOCAL HAZARD
MITIGATION PLAN FOR THE UNINCORPORATED COUNTY**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo seeks to maintain and enhance both a disaster-resistant County and region by reducing the potential loss of life, property damage, and environmental degradation from natural disasters, while accelerating economic recovery from those disasters; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo is committed to increasing the disaster resistance of the infrastructure, health, housing, economy, government services, education, environment, and land use systems in the County of San Mateo, as well as in the Bay Area as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires all cities, counties, and special districts to have adopted a Local Hazard Mitigation Plan to receive disaster mitigation funding from FEMA; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2012, the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Mateo adopted by resolution the County's local Annex to the regional multi-jurisdictional hazards mitigation plan as its Local Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to make a minor modification to the Annex it adopted in March 2012 by the addition of a reference to project(s) which will mitigate flood hazards associated with Butano Creek in Pescadero.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County's 2010 Association of Bay Area Governments Local Hazard Mitigation Plan ("Taming Natural Disasters") is modified by the addition of text to read as follows: "Including projects for mitigation of flood hazards from Butano Creek in Pescadero," as specifically shown in blue text on page 5, Item 5, of Attachment 1, which is incorporated by this reference.
