RESOLUTION AMENDING THE MENTAL HEALTH & SUBSTANCE ARUSE

RECOVERY COMMISSION BYLAWS

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, this board has previously adopted a resolution specifying the responsibilities and membership of the Mental Health & Substance Abuse Recovery Commission (MHSARC) standing rules for its governance; and

**WHEREAS**, this board now wishes to further clarify those responsibilities and membership provisions; and

WHEREAS, Welfare and Institutions Code § 5604.5 provides that each local mental health board shall develop bylaws to be approved by the governing body which is defined as the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the MHSARC desires to amend the bylaws to include: (1) a seat designated as Law Enforcement that will be appointed by the local police chiefs, (2) to allow the Youth Commission to appoint two youth commissioners, (3) to add a rule allowing MHSARC the ability to deem a member as "automatically resigned" when that member misses more than three meetings within a twelve month period; and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County MHSARC has adopted the amended bylaws and this Board of Supervisors has been presented with a form of the amended bylaws and has examined it as to both form and content and desires to approve said bylaws.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the amended bylaws approved by the San Mateo County MHSARC are hereby approved.

## IT IS HEREBY FURTHER DETERMINED AND ORDERED THAT:

- The MHSARC may include a seat designated as Law Enforcement that will be appointed by the local police chiefs; and
- 2. The Youth Commission may appoint two youth commissioners, as their rules provide; and
- 3. MHSARC may add a rule allowing MHSARC the ability to deem a member "automatically resigned" when that member misses more than three meetings within a twelve month period.
