RESOLUTION A) ACCEPTING THE CERTIFICATE OF THE CHIEF ELECTIONS OFFICER AS THE STATEMENT OF THE RESULTS OF THE VOTE AS DETERMINED BY THE OFFICIAL CANVASS OF THE NOVEMBER 6, 2012 PRESIDENTIAL GENERAL ELECTION; B) DECLARING THE PERSONS ELECTED TO CERTAIN OFFICES; AND C) DECLARING THE RESULTS OF CERTAIN MEASURES VOTED ON

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Chief Elections Officer has completed the official canvass of the complete returns of the votes cast at the Presidential General Election held throughout the County of San Mateo on November 6, 2012, has prepared in accordance with law a statement of votes polled at said election held on said date, and has presented a certified copy of said statement to this Honorable Board; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Elections Officer will deliver a duplicate of the certified statement to the California Secretary of State and to the county central committee of each political party; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Elections Officer will deliver to each person elected a certificate of election, signed and authorized by the Chief Elections Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Elections Officer has also determined that the number of persons who filed declarations of candidacy for certain offices does not exceed the

number of positions available; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 15400 of the Elections Code, the governing body of a jurisdiction shall declare elected or nominated to each office voted on at each election under its jurisdiction the person having the highest number of votes for that office or the person who was otherwise duly elected or nominated, and pursuant to that same Section the governing body shall also declare the results of each election under its jurisdiction as to each measure voted on at the election; and

WHEREAS, this Board is the governing body for the County of San Mateo.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND HEREBY ORDERED that the Deputy Clerk of the Board shall enter upon the minutes of this meeting of this Board of Supervisors said abstract or Statement of Votes polled at said election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Statement of Votes polled shall be and is hereby adopted as the official vote of said election throughout the County of San Mateo, State of California, on November 6, 2012; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following named persons have received the highest number of votes for their respective offices, are hereby ordered and declared duly elected:
