RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING**

GINA PAPAN

In Recognition of Her Exemplary Service on the Millbrae City Council

WHEREAS, Gina Papan was elected to the City Council in 2005 and re-elected in 2009, and served as Mayor in 2007 and 2013, and as Vice Mayor in 2012; and

WHEREAS, Gina Papan, during her tenure, focused on efficiency by continuing negotiations for the Fire Department merger with Central County Fire and San Bruno Fire, adoption of the Economic Development Plan, strengthening the sustainability of Millbrae finances through revenue enhancement, citywide way-finding and monumental signage, and furthering public and private partnerships to benefit the Millbrae community; and

WHEREAS, Gina Papan has represented the City of Millbrae on several Boards and Commissions, including: City and County Association of Governments Board of Directors and Legislative Committee; Congestion Management Program and Environmental Quality Committee (CMEQ); High Speed Rail Policymakers Working Group; San Mateo County Council of Cities; Mayor's Civic Coordinating Council; Budget/Finance Subcommittee; Field Agreement Subcommittee; Fire Shared Services Subcommittee; San Mateo County Housing Endowment and Regional Trust; Grand Boulevard Task Force; Peninsula Congestion Relief Alliance; San Mateo County Emergency Services Council; and the Airport Land Use Committee; and

WHEREAS, Gina Papan's commitment to the community includes involvement in non-profit and community organizations, and she serves as the director of John's Closet, which has provided free, new clothing to more than 13,000 underserved children, and she is also a Co-Director the John Papan Memorial Scholarship Fund named in honor of her late brother; and

WHEREAS, Gina Papan grew up in Millbrae and graduated from Capuchino High School, earned her Bachelor's degree at the University of California, Santa Barbara and her law degree from University of the Pacific's McGeorge School of Law, later completed the Senior Executives in State and Local Government program at Harvard University, Kennedy School of Government, and has served as a Deputy Attorney General for the State of California for 19 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California hereby commends Gina Papan in recognition of her exemplary service to the residents of the City of Millbrae and the County of San Mateo.
